

4. That the Petitioner shall not be upon the land pursuant upon the investigation for a period longer than one year without the consent in writing from the Respondents or by further authority of this Court as may be necessary.
5. That the Petitioners, their agents and contractees, shall abide by all of the provisions of the aforesaid code section in all other respects.
6. That Respondents are the owners of a certain tract or parcel of real estate containing 31 acres, more or less, situate in Lost River District, Hardy County, West Virginia, designated on _____, and being the same real estate obtained by _____ dated May 10, 1947, and recorded in the Hardy County Clerk's Office in Deed Book 79, Page 281, (less a 1 acre out conveyance _____, recorded in Deed Book 183, Page 112). _____ a March 31, 1967, and the appraisalment of his Estate recorded in the Hardy County Clerk's Office in Appraisalment Book 10, Page 435, lists the Respondents herein as his sole heirs at law.
7. That the aforesaid real estate is the subject of this request for permission to enter thereupon.

THEREUPON, the Petitioners respectfully request that the Court, subsequent to the appropriate inquiry, grant Petitioners the right to enter upon the above referenced real estate for the purposes set forth herein. Petitioners request such other general and specific relief as is appropriate, related to the matter and the statutory provisions.
